Operation Stand Down

To all volunteers who are participating in operation Stand Down 2013:

I want to thank you in advance for your personal contribution to this effort. Your involvement will change you in ways you can't even imagine right now. I want to give you a few pointers from my own experiences:

1. The MAPHN double-tent will be indoors this year. After careful consideration of the comfort levels of the volunteers and visitors, access to electrical service and availability of water and drainage, we will be indoors for the first time and housed next to medical. We can expect to cross-refer.
2. We will have chilled bottled water, juice and coffee for you.
3. Wear comfortable clothing and sneakers. Civies are fine. Nurses might want to wear a lab coat or scrubs. We will get dirty.
4. Bring your work ID with you. If you are stuck in the registration area, call my cell phone and I will come meet you. It will be very busy there around 10-12. Try to get there before that time.
5. Lunch/snacks will be provided for our tent volunteers on Friday. There is a food tent for veterans and volunteers. You can do that if you prefer.
6. Once inside the camp, you can leave, you are not restricted or hostage to the camp, but you will need to reenter through registration.
7. There is a campfire at night if you want to stay beyond the provision times (when the service tents such as ours are available). You are welcome to stay the night too, if you wish, but you should bring your own gear and save the gear donations for the veterans.
8. This is run as an Incident Command site for refugees. I am not the Incident Commander.
9. I will have all the supplies except that which was requisitioned earlier and those that you volunteered to bring in which case, bring them with you or make sure that they are dropped off to the office of the Framingham Veteran Agent Town Hall Framingham.
10. Please help maintain order in the tent: we are VERY popular, and it can get VERY busy. YOU NEED TO LET ME KNOW when you need a break. Please pace yourselves.
